OPEN NH / NSTA Open Access License

OPEN NH has partnered with the National Science Teachers Association to offer deals for districts and teachers for the NSTA online resources available in the sciences. The OPEN NH / NSTA Open Access Licenses are purchased for a period of 1 year. OPEN NH courses must be taken within the period of the license. The following packages describe special offers NH e-Learning for Educators and NSTA has created especially for the SAU, district, school, or teacher.

OPEN Access Package 1 Open Access to all NSTA materials for the period of 1 year.
\$150.00 / teacher – up to 10 teachers. ~ \$135.00 / teacher – over 10 teachers.

OPEN Access Package 2 Open Access to all NSTA materials for the period of 1 year. One OPEN NH course to be taken in any session delivered during that year.
\$225.00 / teacher – up to 10 teachers. ~ \$202.50 / teacher – over 10 teachers.

OPEN Access Package 3 Open Access to all NSTA materials for the period of 1 year. Two OPEN NH courses to be taken in any session delivered during that year.
\$300.00 / teacher – up to 10 teachers. ~ \$270.00 / teacher – over 10 teachers.

OPEN Access Package 4 Open Access to all NSTA materials for the period of 1 year. Three OPEN NH courses to be taken in any session delivered during that year.
\$375.00 / teacher – up to 10 teachers. ~ \$337.50 / teacher – over 10 teachers.

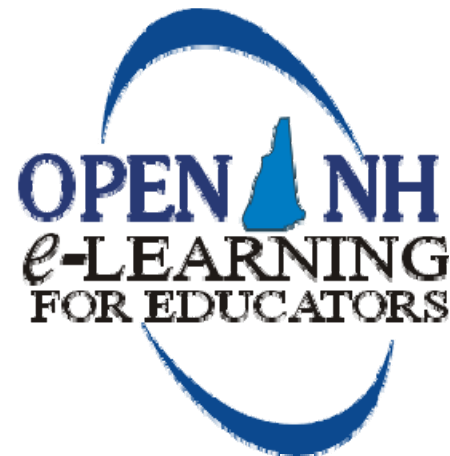
OPEN Access Package 5 Open Access to all NSTA materials for the period of 1 year. Four OPEN NH courses to be taken in any session delivered during that year.

\$1900 Course Delivery Scenarios

Scenario 1 The district requests one course to be delivered at a time of its choosing for 8 – 25 of its teachers.

- The district will complete the Special Course request form and provide the dates of delivery and the course requested on this form to the OPEN NH project coordinator.

Scenario 2 The district requests to add one course to a regularly scheduled session for 8 – 25 of its teachers during a regular OPEN NH session.

- The district will designate a team leader who will complete the Special Course Delivery Registration form and send it to the OPEN NH Project Coordinator for processing and provide the names, phone numbers, and email addresses for 8 – 25 of their teachers.

Scenario 3 The district requests 20 – 25 seats in one regularly scheduled single course offered during one of the regular OPEN NH sessions.

- The district will designate a team leader who will complete the Special Course Delivery Registration form and send it to the OPEN NH Project Coordinator for processing.

Scenario 4 The district requests 20 – 25 seats in the multiple courses during a regularly scheduled session of OPEN NH courses.

- The district will designate a team leader who will complete the Special Course Delivery Registration form and send it to the OPEN NH Project Coordinator for processing.

\$450 Course Delivery Scenarios

Scenario 5 The district requests seats in one regularly scheduled course offered during one of the regular OPEN NH sessions for 5 teachers.

- The district will designate a team leader who will complete the Special Course Delivery Registration form and send it to the OPEN NH Project Coordinator for processing.

Scenario 6 The district requests 5 seats in the multiple courses during a regularly scheduled session of OPEN NH courses.

- The district will designate a team leader who will complete the Special Course Delivery Registration form and send it to the OPEN NH Project Coordinator for processing.

Convenient Course Delivery

Each course unit runs from Wednesday until the following Tuesday. The courses are divided into 7 units, beginning with the initial face to face orientation meeting and an online course orientation week. Weekly participation requires online readings, projects, tasks or assignments, and discussions. When and where the participation occurs is completely up to the participant's schedule and preferences. An internet connection is all that is required for access to the course. Participants completing the course receive a certificate for 30 contact hours of course participation. Optional graduate credits are available through Plymouth State University.

New Learner Introduction /Orientation Sites

Orientation sessions are held throughout the state just prior to the start of each session. OPEN NH runs four sessions of courses throughout the academic year. These orientation sessions are optional and geared toward orienting participants to the OPEN NH program and ways to be successful with online learning. Our instructors are specially trained in online professional development course facilitation by the Education Development Center as part of the e-Learning for Educators Initiative.
